

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Due to the COVID19 pandemic, much of the WP7 events have moved on-line.

On 1st September 2020, a mixed workshop (in person participants in Tallinn and online participants through live-streaming) with the title “DigiPLACE Tallinn Regional Workshop” was organized by DigiPLACE, with the support of the Estonian Ministry of Economic Affairs and Communications & KiraHub and was featured as a pre-event of the WDBE2020.

It was contributed by ten speakers, was attended by 25 people in person, 49 live connections on-line and had over 150 viewers on Youtube.

The programme included opening messages by Jaan SAAR, Ministry of Economic Affairs & Communications from Estonia who also moderated the event and Riccardo VIAGGI from CECE/DigiPLACE. Project Presentation, its goals, timeline & expectations was explained by Žiga Turk from University of Ljubljana – Slovenia. The Local Perspectives from Estonia and Finland were presented by Jaan SAAR & Toni Luhti, Platform of Trust – Finland. The DigiPLACE Reference Architecture Framework (RAF) was presented by Alberto PAVAN of Politecnico di Milano – Italy and Nicolas NAVILLE, CSTB – France. After the lunch break Alain Zarli of ECTP presented the Strategic Roadmap for DigiPLACE. How to involve the construction stakeholders – the role of the DigiPLACE CoS was presented by Luigi PERISSICH from Federcostruzioni, Italy. After a Q&A some brainstorming about the DigiPLACE RAF took place. The event was wrapped up by Miimu Airaksinen of the Association of Civil Engineers from Finland

The overall duration of the event was 3 hours and 30 minutes.
