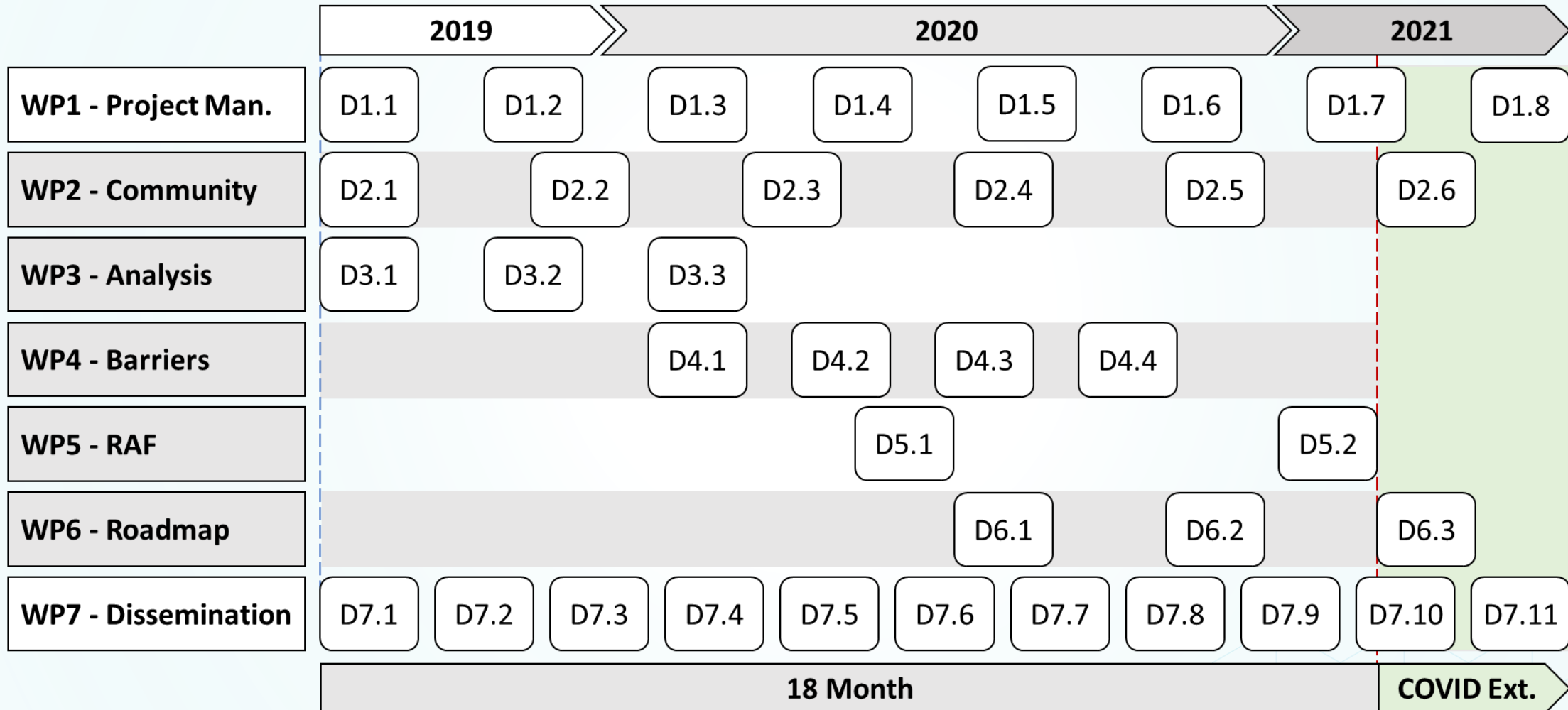


The high-level objective of the **DigiPLACE** project is to create

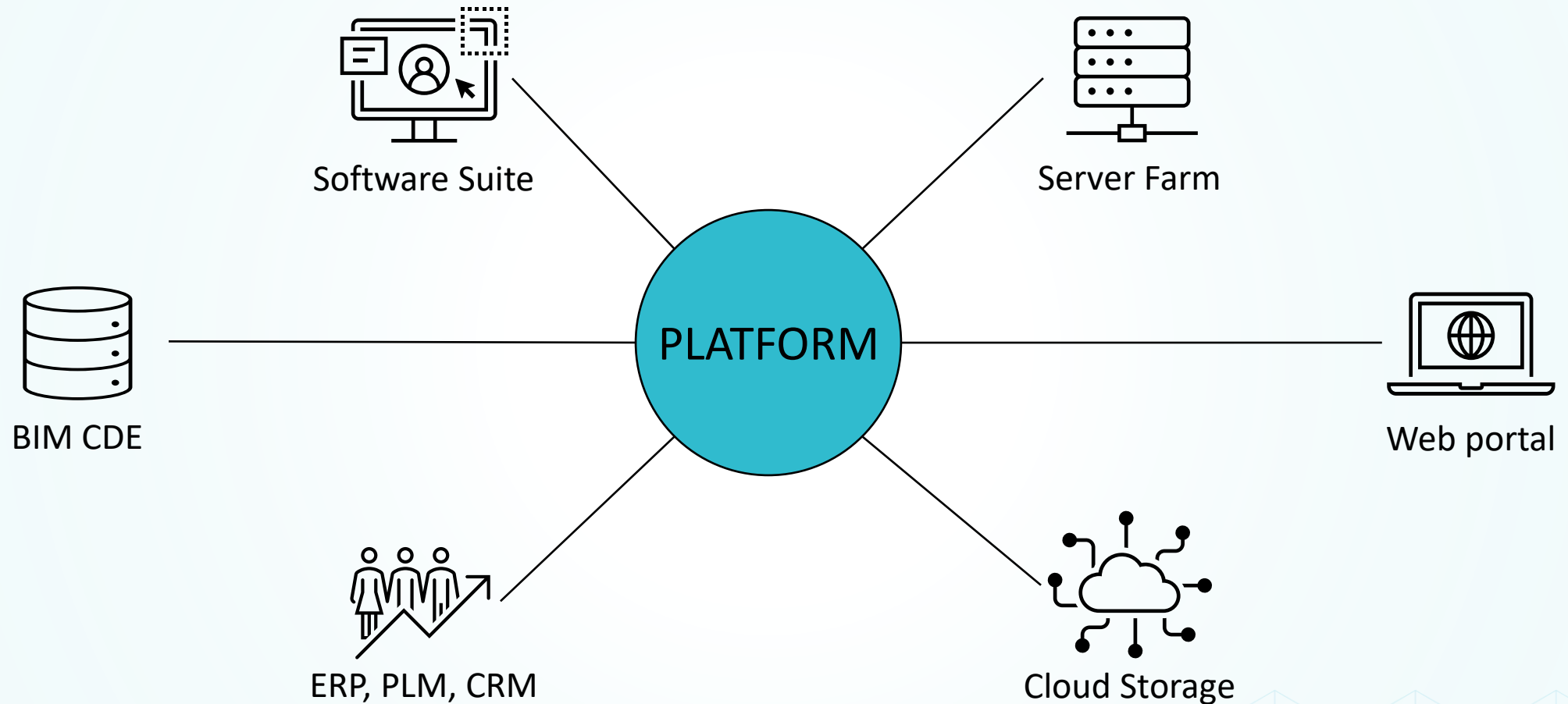
Expected Impact



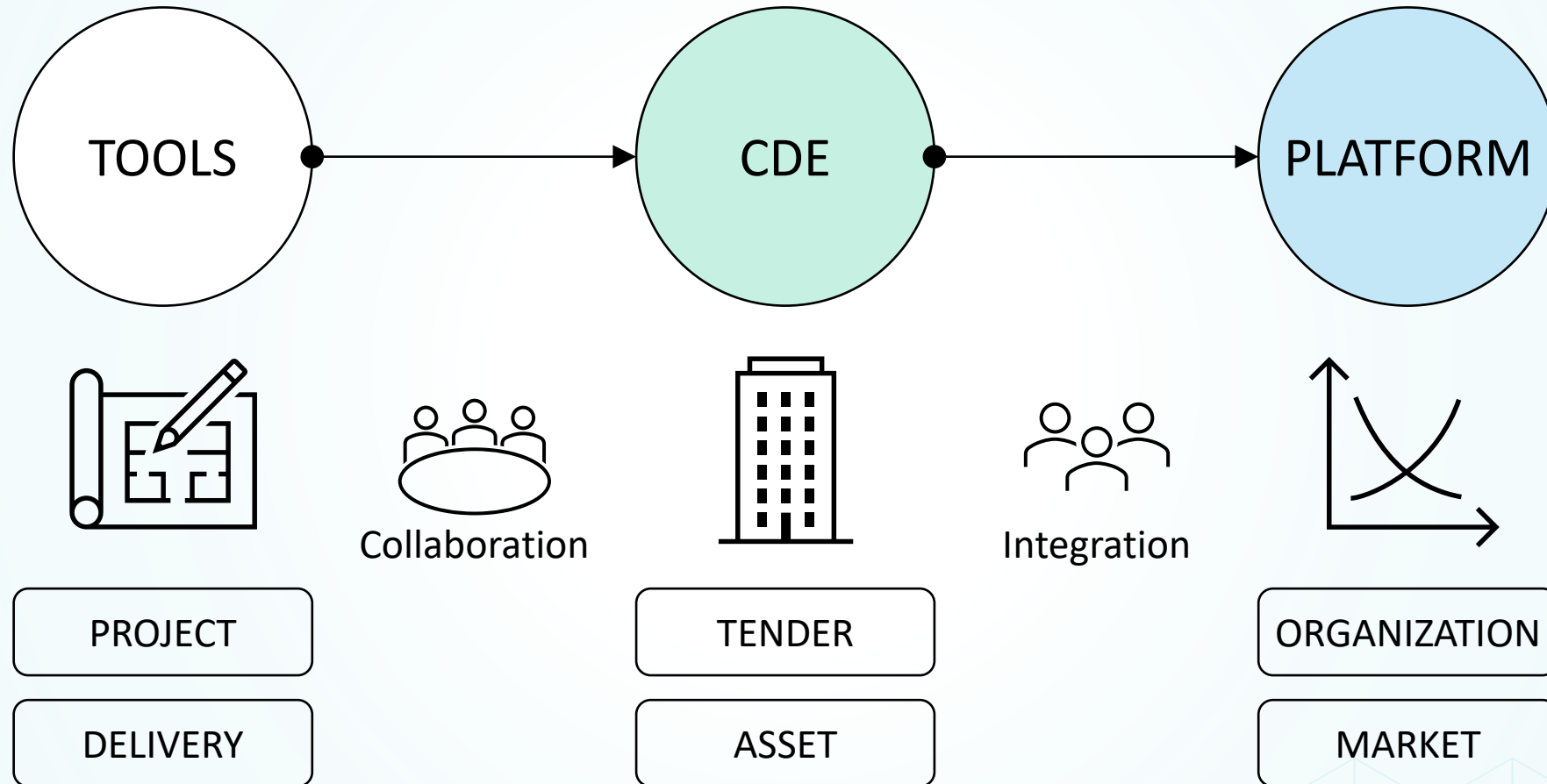
